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FIRE GROUND REPSONSIBILITIES

1.00 PURPOSE

1.01 To serve as a guideline, to outline the roles and responsibilities of personnel operating at an emergency incident.

2.00 OBJECTIVE

2.01 To ensure safe operations at an emergency incident.

2.02 To ensure all personnel at an emergency incident operate within their level of training.

3.00 GUIDELINES

3.01 General fire ground responsibilities:

A. All personnel shall report to the Incident Commander upon arrival at emergency incident.

B. No personnel shall leave scene until released by COMMAND.

C. All personnel involved in an emergency response should to the best of his/her ability to stabilize incident safely and return apparatus to service.

3.02 Command should handle overall responsibilities of incident:

A. Get emergency incident under control.

B. Return resources to service.

3.03 Officers:

A. Assume command or assist COMMAND in bringing incident under control.

B. Assist COMMAND, receive orders and carry out orders to best of his/her ability.

3.04 Active Firefighter:

- A. May have to be Incident Commander.
- B. Upon arrival at scene, if command has been taken report to command post.
- C. Assist COMMAND, receive orders and carry out orders to best of his/her abilities.
- D. Assist in getting resources available for service.

3.05 Probationary Firefighter:

- A. Assist in overall control of emergency incident.
- B. At structure fire, these personnel are not to enter the structure.
- C. May perform overhaul with approval of an Officer, must be accompanied by an active Firefighter or Officer.

3.06 Juniors:

- A. Report to COMMAND.
- B. Assist in exterior tactical operations only.
